



The event commenced with a warm welcome by KG 1 students, the principal of the school, who congratulated the young graduates and thanked the parents and teachers for their support.


The highlight of the event was the distribution of graduation certificates. Each child proudly walked across the stage in their cap and gown, receiving their certificate and posing for photos with their teachers.

Each participant presented well but as


it's a competition one to lose and another to win, so the winners from first standard was




Students' and foundation day










NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

National Mathematics Day






NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY



INTERNATIONAL SUDOKU DAY




